I am enclosing herewith a copy of No. 464/GJ-LA/2007 dated 6th October, 2007 of Election Commission of India (ECI). ECI has directed that at the District Election Officers Level one or more teams comprising of Police Officials, Civil Officers and Videographer shall be formed for each constituency to ensure observance of Model Code of Conduct and enquire. The follow up action on all complaints of this district should be enquired into and steps to be taken by the team. It should report to the Returning Officer and the District Election Officer. The team starts functioning immediately.

I would, therefore, request you to suggest the name of the Police Officer per Constituency who can be inducted into the said team.

Sir,

1. Please analyse the data of non EPIC Electors Polling Station-wise. Strategy has to be worked out to make 100% coverage of the EPIC. In case you do not have polling station-wise data the same may be collected from the Officer-in-charge, District Election Department.
2. I hope the work of missing electors is complete; polling station-wise number of missing electors separately with family linkage and without family linkage may be emailed to the Officer-in-charge, District Election Department.
3. Can the gap in EPIC coverage be explained by missing elector without family linkage? Please ensure that all prepared EPICs are distributed. Electors may be sent a letter under certificate of posting.
4. Please work out tentative names and contact details of Sector Officers and Booth contact person. Election Commission of India has directed that a Sector map/sketch be prepared showing the location of the polling station and the routes. The work of preparation of the same may be taken up immediately.
5. Three(3) EVMs per Assembly Constituency have already been allotted for voters' awareness. ARO in-charge/EROs may arrange to get it collected from the district EVM Cell and work out the strategy of maximizing voters awareness.
6. During the Election we will have the requirement of large numbers of Video Cameras. I would request you to make the tentative list of Video Cameras that may be available on hire.
7. Kindly identify the mobile shadow zones where one or more of the mobile net work do not work. You may kindly like to suggest alternative means of communication for such places e.g. Satellite Phones, RT Sets, extra vehicles/boats for faster coverage.
